**REMEMBER:**

If you are close to an average, this could still be the school for you! Meet with a college rep or go on a college tour to find out more.

Many schools work on a sliding scale so if you have a lower test score, they would still consider you if you have a higher GPA.

Example: Western Michigan accepts you with a 3.0 GPA and 16 on ACT or a 2.6 GPA and a 17 ACT
